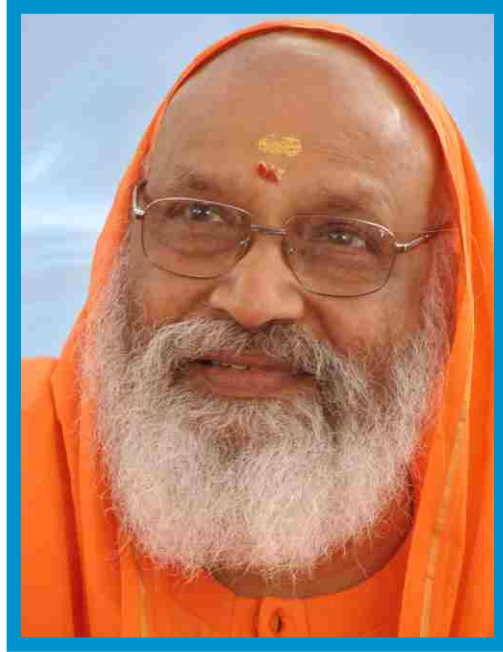

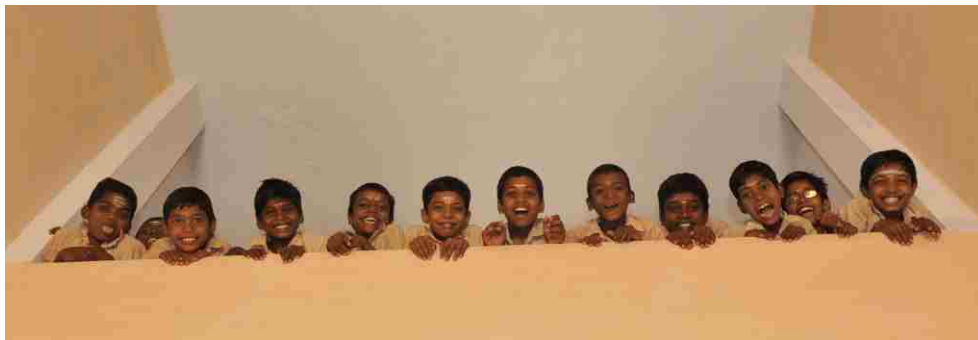
Welcome to AIM for Seva

AIM for Seva is a registered pan-India, non-profitable charitable trust founded by Pujya Swami Dayananda Saraswati. We began our journey to educate and transform the lives of children in rural India in 2000. With a deep understanding of problems faced by children in rural India: commuting long distances to school, domestic pressures, financial strains, lack of extra-curricular activities and much more, AIM for Seva introduced the concept of Free Student Hostels.

Our Free Student Hostels provide complete care to the students, during the critical phase of their mental and physical growth, from Class 4 to Class 12. Nurturing environment, value education, academic coaching, nutrition, health and hygiene awareness, and much more contribute to the students' growth. Self-confident, disciplined students are a welcome addition to any organisation; each student graduating from an AIM for Seva hostel contributes to his or her family, to the community, and thereby to the nation.

Today, we have 97 Free Student Hostels across 16 states in India enabling children in rural India to realise their full potential.





Unlocking the Potential of Rural India

The landmark Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009 is one of the first steps to ensure all children have access to education in India. The schools are open; but how many children in rural India actually make it to school?

The Census 2011 data has revealed two alarming facts: as many as 78 lakh Indian children are forced to earn a livelihood even as they attend schools; and 8.4 crore children don't go to school at all - that's nearly 20 percent of the age group covered under the Right to Education Act. A majority of these children land up wasting their time, doing domestic chores or nothing at all.

The AIM for Seva Impact

- Education to Employment is the focus: over 100 students cleared their class 12 board examinations and went onto pursue higher education.
- 15% of our students went onto to pursue higher studies and have found jobs in corporate houses like Sundaram Finance, Wipro, Tata Consultancy Services. They are all first generation learners.
- Skilling India - A skill test is conducted every quarter and based on the student's capabilities they are guided to enrol for courses
- Encourage cross-cultural Exchange - over 500 students have moved out of their home states to educate themselves
- We foster the cause of girl child education: we have 18 Free Student Hostels for girls.
- Over 3500 students study in AIM for Seva's Schools - Khategaon in Madhya Pradesh and Dharmapuri, Kadalur, Manjakkudi and Sembangudi in Tamil Nadu.

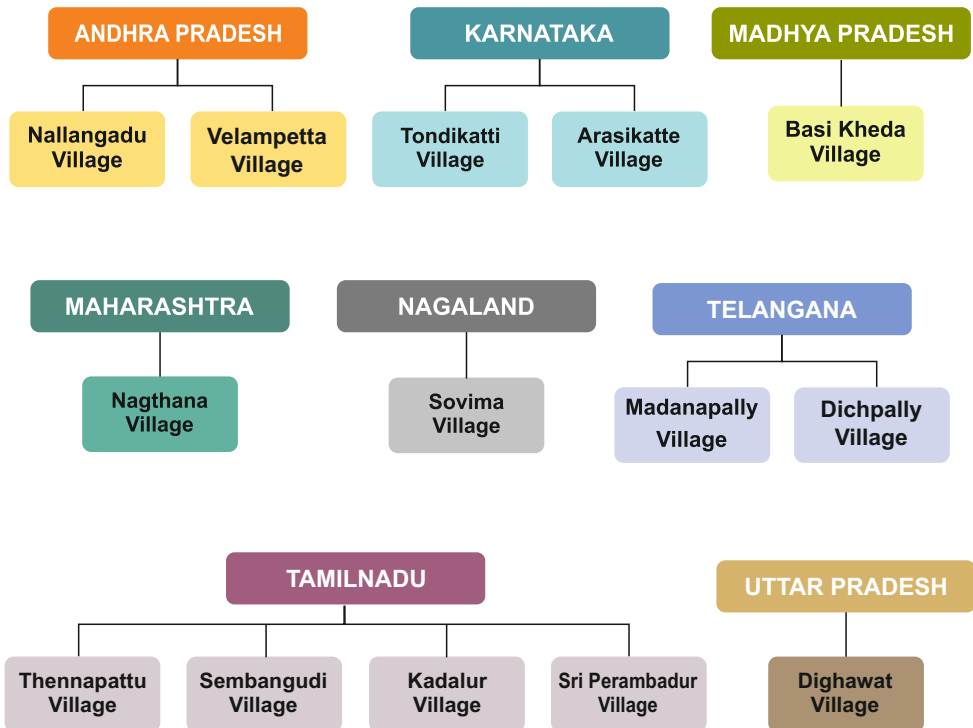

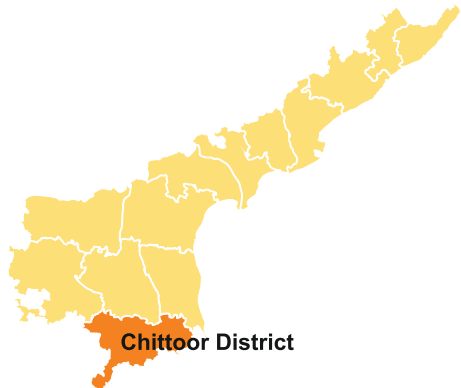

Project Details

Nallangadu is a very large village located in Bangarupalem Taluk in Chittoor district, Andhra Pradesh. There are a total of 568 families residing in this village. As per Population Census 2011, the Nallangadu village has population of 2186 of which 1072 are males while 1114 are female.

According to records, there are only two schools in Chittoor district that teach Sanskrit. One is at Yerpedu village in Srikalahasthi and the second one is S.V.S. High School, Nallangadu.

Within a five-kilometre radius, there are several villages around Nallangadu; they are Thoompayanapalle, Thumba Kuppam, Sadakuppam Paleru and Mathyam.

Project Details

In Yelamapeta village located in Kaikalur Taluk, Krishna District in Andhra Pradesh, AIM for Seva already has a Free Student Hostel for Boys. The current premise in the village Yelamapeta is home to 20 boys. Boys living in this Free Student Hostel are sons of farmers and daily-wage earners. A majority of them are first-generation learners. Inaugurated in 2012, the hostel has earned itself a good reputation and there has been an increasing demand by the local communities to admit more students. Currently, functioning out of a 150 year old property, there is a need to construct a new building. As there is sufficient land space within the existing premise, we have agreed to construct a new building for these boys and accommodate more students.

Each and every day, children wake up smiling and with gratitude for the life that they have. Their friends back home are found whiling away time, working in the fields or getting married. The boys living in this Free Student Hostel got the opportunity to change their lives, because of generous donors.

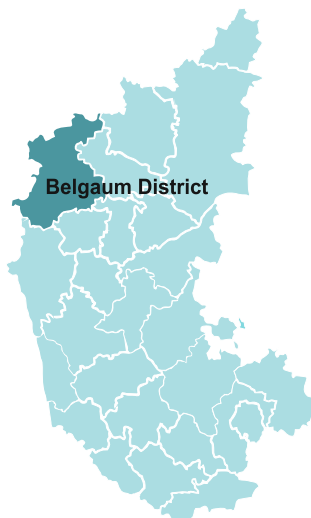

Project Details

Tondikatti village is located in Ramdurg Taluk of Belgaum district in Karnataka, India. It is situated 110 kilometres away from the district headquarters Belgaum, and 540 kilometres away from the state capital Bengaluru.

The total geographical area of the village is 1584.42 hectares and it has a population of 1,700 people. Data reveals that there are approximately 346 houses in Tondikatti village.

Agriculture is the primary occupation here, however, there are many limestone quarries and cement factories located nearby that employ the villages for a daily wage. The new hostel for boys that has been planned will provide educational opportunities to the children of these workers. Around Tondikatti village there are 8 large towns and in total 115 villages; children from these villages will benefit from this hostel.

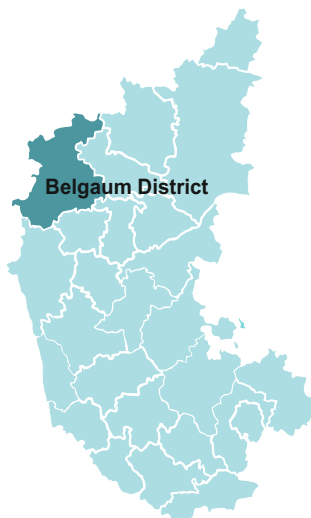

Project Details

Arasikatte is a small village in Arkalgud Taluk in Udupi District in Karnataka, India. It is 205 kilometres away from Bengaluru. Sakleshpur, Hassan, Madikeri and Arasikere are the towns close to Arasikatte village.

Census data reveals that this village has 329 people and 74 households. Approximately 40% of the locals are illiterate and unemployed. Both men and women work as farmers or find daily wage jobs as and when they come their way.

The reason we choose this site is because the Udupi Taluk block covers 106 villages from Shirur to Yennagudde. There are many children who require support and have shown a keen interest in joining AIM for Seva's Free Student Hostel. They want to equip themselves with the knowledge and skills necessary to create a better future for themselves.



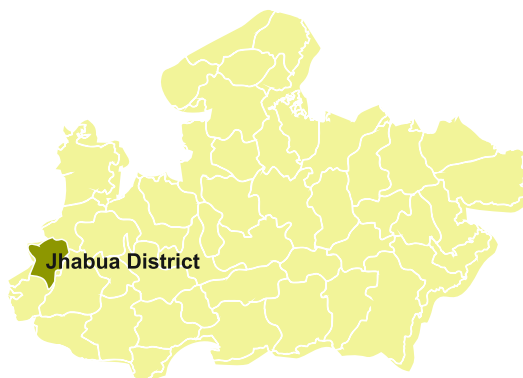

Project Details

According to the Census 2011 information, Kheda village located in Jhabua Taluk of Jhabua district in Madhya Pradesh, India, is a gram panchayat. With just over 4500 people in the village, there are 756 households. There is no railway station within a 10-kilometre radius; the major railway station is Ratlam Junction, which is 71 kilometres away from Kheda village. Jhabua district is believed to have the lowest literacy rate in Madhya Pradesh.



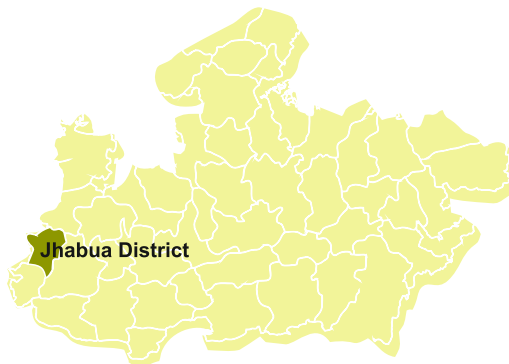

Project Details

Basi Kheda village in Jhabua district is located in Western Madhya Pradesh. The terrain is hilly and undulating and it is a drought-prone area. Jhabua is one of the 24 districts in the state that receives funds from the Backward Regions Grant Fund Programme.

Considered to be one of the 250 most backward districts of our country, Jhabua has a predominantly tribal population and over 3% belong to scheduled castes. This Adivasi district has the lowest literacy rate amongst districts of Madhya Pradesh.

Around half the population lives below the poverty line. The new co-education school for tribal children will have fully furnished classrooms, library, labs, office rooms and an environment to inspire and nurture young minds.

Project Details

According to Population Census 2011, the Nagthana village is located in Washim Taluk in Maharashtra. A gram panchayat, this village has approximately 1500 people and 292 houses.

The villages that are within a 10-kilometre radius are Somthana, Adoli, Swargaon, Shirsala and Sonkhas. There are many reputed educational institutions that children living in this Free Student Hostel can enroll in.

Project Details

Sovima is a large village located near Chumukedima town in Dimapur district, Nagaland. The village has a total of 640 families residing and according to the Population Census 2011, the population is 3220; 15% of the population are children within six years of age. Though the literacy rate is fairly high in this village, half of the population remains unemployed.

Unlike the other villages in Dimapur, Sovima is significant because it has never had any land disputes with any neighbouring villages; nor has the village faced any eviction drive ever since its inception post Independence. Considered a peaceful and progressive village, it is administrated by the Sarpanch (Head of Village) who is elected by the villagers.

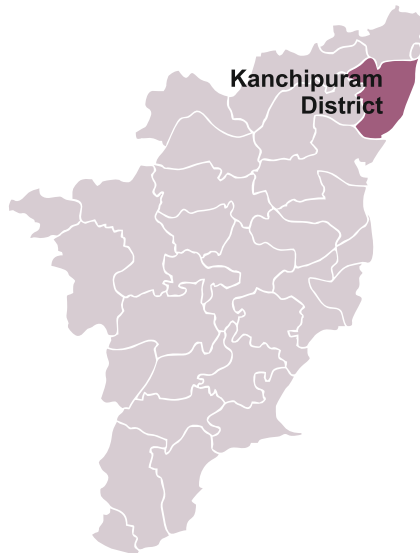

AIM for Seva's Swami Dayananda Rotary Matriculation School in Kadalur, Tamil Nadu was established in 2005. Currently, the school caters to 640 students from Class 1 to Class 10. Implementing the Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act 2009, Swami Dayananda Matriculation School will be creating a model to accept and provide education to all children. The new block with fully furnished classrooms is required to accommodate new students. The new block will have 18 new classrooms.

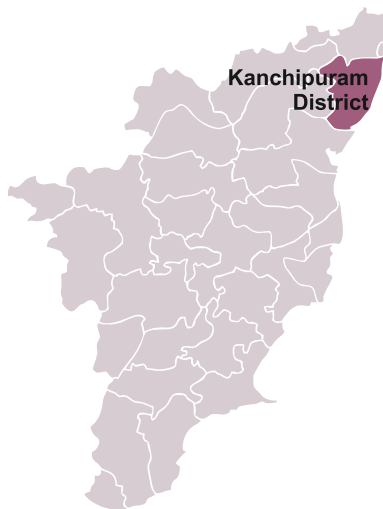

Kadalur is a village panchayat located in the Kanchipuram district of Tamil Nadu, India. The metropolitan city Chennai is 70-kilometre away.

The Kadalur village has a population of 6175, and 1619 households as per the population census of 2011. The village has a very low literacy rate in comparison to other parts of Tamil Nadu. In 2011, the literacy rate of Kadalur village was 66.39% compared to 80.09% of Tamil Nadu.

Project Details

AIM for Seva's sister organisation Swami Dayananda Educational Trust based in Pujya Swamiji's janmabhoomi Manjakkudi, drives several rural empowerment initiatives in the Tiruvarur belt. The Semangudi Higher Secondary School for boys and girls, has been managed by the Trust since 2005. The older buildings have been refurbished, additional buildings constructed, well-equipped science and computer labs set up and new courses introduced.

A majority of children in this school belong to the scheduled caste and come from the surrounding 130 villages.

The Tiruvarur region has the lowest literacy rate in comparison to the other parts of Tamil Nadu, and this school strives to bridge this divide. As a policy, every child who seeks admission in this school is given a place and encouraged to stay on in school.

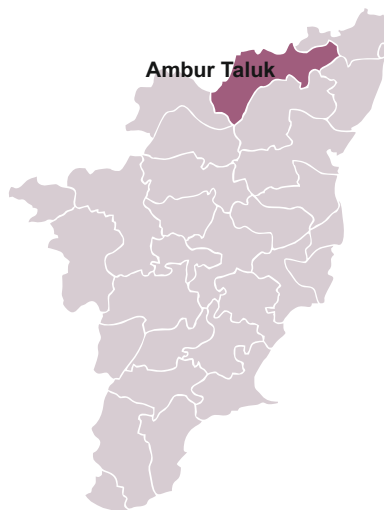

Project Details

Thennambattu village is situated 10 km away from Ambur Taluk, around 50 km away from Vellore district and 200 km away from the state capital. The nearest prosperous town of Kancheepuram is 21 km away. The total population of this village is 883 people and there are about 208 households. The area has a lake, a forest and a known cricket ground.

Agriculture is the main occupation of the villagers and most are labourers who work on a daily-wage basis. Ambur Taluk covers four towns and 73 villages.

Since the children cannot travel long distances to the few schools in the area, AIM for Seva aims to build and manage a new free student hostel here to cater to the local and nearby areas.

Madanapally is a village in Makloor Taluk in Nizamabad District, Telangana. It is located 13-kilometre from the district headquarters Nizamabad.

Madanapally is surrounded by Navipet Mandal towards West, Nizamabad Mandal towards South, Nandipet Mandal towards North, Renjal Mandal towards West.

There are several schools around this village that children from this Free Student Hostel can attend. They are the K.G.V.B Makloor, Sri Chandar Techno School, Navya Bharathi Global High School, Navya Bharathi Global High School and Z.P. High School.

Project Details

Dichpally is a small village in Dichpally mandal in Nizamabad district and comes under the Nadpally Panchayath. It is surrounded by villages like Nanpally, Amruthapur, Mentrajally, Dharmaram, Indalwai and Suddula. There is a high density of scheduled tribe population in these villages and they often migrate.

According to the Census 2011 information, Dichpalle has a total population of 4,709 peoples with just over 1000 households. Nizamabad is nearest town to Dichpalle which is approximately 18 kilometers away.

There are several schools around this village that children from this Free Student Hostel can attend. They include Z.P. High School, Vidya High School, Vani High School and Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya.

Project Details

As per the Population Census 2011, there are total 494 families residing in the village Dighawat in Uttar Pradesh. The population of children of age 0-6 years in Dighawat village is 419 and statistics reveal that the literacy rate of Dighawat is 66.6%.

The Vivekanand Mission Hospital, one of AIM for Seva's health care projects in Uttar Pradesh, is situated at Dighawat village. A voluntary and charitable organisation, the hospital has been providing health care support, primarily eye care treatments, to the villages in and around Dighawat for over a decade now.

Within the hospital premise, there is sufficient space to construct a Free Student Hostel. There is a growing number of young children in this district who are out of school; setting up a free student hostel in this village, where there are good educational facilities, will allow us to ensure children go to school and stay on in school.

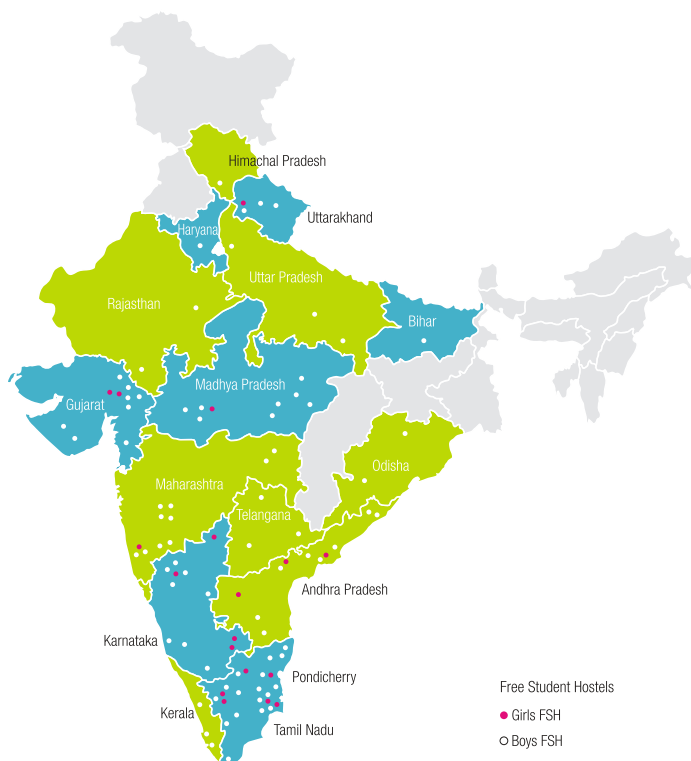
